



Summer Children's Show COVID Guidelines For Audiences

Live Theatre Workshop is committed to bringing great theatre to our audiences and returning to our love of bringing audiences and artists together. We closely monitor CDC and local health department recommendations to ensure that all patrons, staff, and artists remain safe and healthy. Below are our current guidelines and expectations for a safe return to live theatre. These guidelines will be updated as health recommendations improve or worsen.



LIMITED SEATING

All productions will be limited to 50% capacity. All seating will be reserved. Two or more chairs will separate all parties. Reservations are highly encouraged in order to maintain distance throughout the theatre and maximize seating capacity.



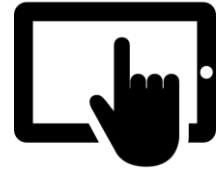
MASKS

We ask that all patrons wear masks while inside the building. Many of our young patrons are not able to be vaccinated and we must work together to keep them safe. Performers will not be wearing masks during the show and are all vaccinated and screened weekly for COVID-19.



SELF-WELLNESS ASSESSMENT

All patrons, staff, performers, and volunteers are asked to ensure they are feeling well and without COVID related symptoms before attending a production. If you aren't feeling well or aren't sure, we will reschedule your tickets.



DIGITAL PROGRAMS

There will be no physical programs. Programs can be accessed at the theatre with a smartphone and can also be emailed to you upon request. Show and performer information will be posted in the Lobby.



CONCESSIONS

Prepackaged concessions will be available for purchase to enjoy outdoors in our beautiful outdoor campus.



HAND SANITIZER

Hand Sanitizer will be available to all throughout the building.



WILL CALL TICKETS

There will be no physical tickets. When you arrive you can check in with just your name.



FACILITIES

All high touch surfaces and seating will be sanitized regularly and bathrooms will be sanitized frequently.



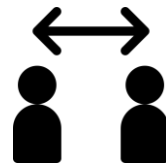
AIR FLOW

HEPA filters and HVAC fans will run throughout the theatre to ensure a consistent exchange of fresh air.



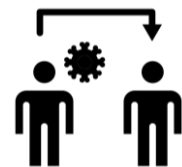
LIMITED TIME

Seating will begin no earlier than 30 mins before show time, with assistance and accommodations for patrons with special needs. Patrons are welcome to wait for seating in any of our outdoor spaces.



SOCIAL DISTANCE

There will be plenty of outdoor space to spread out before, during intermission, and after the show. We ask that everyone maintain distance according to local safety guidelines.



COVID EXPOSURE

All patrons, staff, performers, and volunteers are asked to remain at home if they have been in contact with someone who is known or suspected to have COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
