Covid -19 Guidelines

- Prior to Arrival please complete the Home Health Screening Checklist
 - Fever of 100 degrees or higher
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - New lost of taste or smell
 - Sore Throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Vomiting
 - Diarrhea
- If your child, or any household member, has any of the symptoms on the checklist, please keep your child home.

- Camp size will be limited to 10 students per class.
- Students will not be permitted on campus prior to 7:50 a.m.
- Parents and siblings must remain outside of the building during pick up and drop off time. The lobby will remain closed during classes. We will have a check in/out table outside.
- Students are to wait in the parking lot until their instructor comes out to sign them in.
- Before entering the building, students will have their temperature checked using a no-touch thermometer.
- Upon entering their assigned theatre classroom for the day, before and after snacks/lunch and before they leave school for the day students will wash their hands. Additionally, students will use hand sanitizer frequently.
- All students and staff will wear a properly fitted cloth facial covering at all times other than eating. Students will have the opportunity for outdoor mask breaks throughout the day. We recommend for students to bring a 2nd mask in case their first mask gets soiled. (bloody nose, sneezing, etc.)
- All students and staff are required to remain 6 feet apart at all times.
- There will be no sharing of personal or class materials, including food.
- All camp times have been adjusted to allow for extra cleaning.
- Please communicate with Live Theatre Workshop administration if you or a family member test positive for COVID 19.
- Please wait 14 days before coming to a class if you were in close contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19 (even if you test negative within the 14 day time period).
- We are working out details on how our showcases will be presented each week to ensure the health and safety of all participants. Limited seating and/or virtual showcases are one possibility we are exploring. Decisions will be set as we get closer to the start of camps and have a better understanding of the pandemic's trajectory.
